The Game of Archery Cricket

Official League Rules:

1. All standard game rules apply with exceptions noted.
2. Exception to game rule #9. In order for the arrow to be scored, it must “Break The Line”. Meaning, the arrow must be touching the scoring area. Thus breaking the line surrounding the scoring area.
3. Tie breakers are decided by shooting arrow for arrow at the bull’s eyes until a winner is decided.
4. Match play (head to head) is best (2) out of (3) games to determine a winner.
5. Binoculars or a spotting scope may be used to determine shot placement.
6. Player may use a compound, traditional, or crossbow to play.
7. Crossbows using magnification scopes must use the “Advanced Player” Rule. See score card for complete rule description.
8. Handicap: Can be applied to a player who shoots at a level above average.
9. Championship brackets are single game elimination.
10. Absent Shooter: A player can either do a make-up shoot or take a loss for the match.
11. Absent Opponent: If your opponent is absent, you are required to shoot a minimum of two games to completion and turn in your score card.
12. Make-up score cards must have at least two games completed.
13. Make-up score card: In the event you and your opponent turn in a score card and there is a tie for one of the games. See rule for tie breakers.
14. Make-up score card: In the event you and your opponent turn in a score card and neither of you have won both games. A third game must be played to determine a clear winner for the match.
15. Make-up games are the responsibility of the player.

16. Make-up games must be conducted within two weeks of the match or an automatic loss will be recorded.
17. When conducting a make-up shoot, the honor system is always applied.
18. False score cards will be disqualified.
19. For an absent player: A substitute or guest may shoot in their place.
20. Substitute or Guest player scores do NOT take the place of the absent player.
21. Amendments: A rule can be altered. It must be voted on by the league and recorded by the league secretary.
22. All discrepancies shall be the responsibility of the league secretary to resolve.
